- Stay with a host family in an indigenous community in the Amazon Basin
- Learn about traditional healing from a local shaman
- Visit a geothermal hot springs

Adventures in the Galapagos Include:

- Explore San Cristobal, Santa Cruz, North Seymour and Isabela Islands
- Visit the Charles Darwin Research Station
- Hike to the white sand beaches of Tortuga Bay and view marine iguanas
- Participate in a reforestation service project on Santa Cruz Island
- Visit magnificent Frigate Bird and Blue-Footed Boobie nests
- Visit the giant tortoise breeding center and snorkel with sea lions, sea turtles and rays in the Islets of Las Tintoreras and Kicker Rock.
- Horseback ride to Chico Volcano to view fumaroles and overnight camping in a private reserve.
- Tour Academy Bay by kayak and swim in Las Grietas, a network of flooded volcanic cracks
